Why is this course timely for you and your organization?

Supply chain disruptions will always occur. Because these events pose a major threat to organizational survival and success, managers appreciate why it is important for their organizations to have resilient supply chains.

However, building resilient supply chains is often costly and can create inefficiencies. At the same time, cutting costs inappropriately can create supply chain vulnerabilities. For organizations in African countries, where financial resources are more limited and customers are price sensitive, achieving supply chain resilience cost-effectively is essential for long-term organizational success.

To achieve these results, managers require a deeper understanding of the supply chain resilience options available to their organization. Some options foster operational continuity, while others enable strategic renewal. These options not only work best under different circumstances but also carry different cost implications and require different approaches to pursuing them.

This course offers participants knowledge, tools, and frameworks that will guide them to make more informed decisions that maximize their organizations' potential to build and sustain supply chain resilience in a cost-effective manner.

What will you learn?

The course integrates practical cases and tried-and-tested frameworks to help participants develop knowledge and skills for building and sustaining supply chain resilience cost-effectively. The specific knowledge that participants will acquire include:

1. Supply chain resilience options and their trade-offs
2. Supply chain disruption and response profiling and matching
3. Cost–benefit analysis of resources and strategies that enable supply chain resilience
4. Roadmap for orchestrating supply chain resilience in a cost-effective manner

targets top-level, middle, and functional-level managers, as well as lower-level team members involved in managing disruptions, risks, crises, and disasters within their organizations, operations, or supply chains to ensure operational continuity and enable strategic adaptation and transformation.

- Operations, production, or manufacturing managers
- Risk, crisis, or disaster managers and related teams
- Top executives (e.g., CEOs, managing directors, general managers)

The course is delivered by Dr. Essuman, a supply chain resilience expert with a deep understanding of the disruptions and constraints and opportunities that organizations and supply chains in Africa face. His doctoral research focused on helping organizations understand when and how they possess operational resilience to supply chain disruptions and how such resilience can be developed to gain efficiency advantages.

Since then, he has conducted extensive research on these topics and has been teaching topics on supply chain disruptions and resilience to master's students for the past three years. His research on operational resilience has shaped several international organizations' research and policy papers. Dominic has received training and certification in Business Continuity from The Business Continuity Institute (UK), is a Fellow of the Higher Education Academy (FHEA), UK, and is a Lecturer in Sustainable Management at the University of Sheffield, UK.
